- 1 Raise awareness of the benefits of learning in the workplace and community
- 2 Support learners in developing their skills and qualifications
- 3 Provide advice and guidance to employees
- 4 Establish partnerships with learning providers
- 5 Identify learning needs
- 6 ULRs have statutory rights to train and carry out their duties
- 7 Secure equal opportunities in learning
- 8 Monitor the quality of learning provision
- 9 Negotiate learning agreements with the employer to embed learning into the workplace
- 10 Increase membership density by using learning as an organising tool
